Dr. Cherae Farmer-Dixon is currently the Dean for the School of Dentistry and Professor with tenure, in the Department of Dental Public Health. She is the only African American female dean among the 65 dental schools in the United States. Prior to assuming the role of dean, she served as the Associate Dean for Academic and Student Affairs. She served on the faculty of Meharry Medical College for twenty-four (24) years. Dr. Farmer-Dixon also serves her country as a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Army Reserve, further defining her commitment to service. Dr. Cherae Farmer-Dixon is a driven healthcare professional with a passion for academia that promotes equipping future healthcare professionals to serve the underserved.

As she endeavors to delve into the fullest extent of her profession, Dr. Farmer-Dixon has been actively involved in research activities that have dealt with oral health disparities, caries in low-income children, community outreach and intervention, and addressing minority dental school enrollment. Her research endeavors have led to presentations at local, national and international meetings. Her publications have appeared in peer reviewed journals. She has also received numerous awards from students and local, state, and national organizations such as the 2015 DentaQuest Health Equity Heroes Award, the 2014 National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Inc. (Metro Nashville Chapter) Davis-Galloway Empowerment Award; the Nashville Medical News 2014 Women to Watch Recognition; the Meharry National Alumni Association Alumnus Faculty of the Year Award; the Meharry National Alumni Association Presidential Award Recipient; the Camp Atterbury Army Dental Service and Leadership Award, and countless others.
